<p style="text-align: center;">TABLET</p> <p>Tall, wide and not very thick The top can be straight, curved or a fancy design (cross, dice, squares,</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">GOTHIC (gothic tablet)</p> <p>Tall and similar to a tablet but the high arched top makes it a gothic tablet.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">THE BLOCK</p> <p>It tends to look like a block of stone cut into a shape. It is quite thick and can vary in height and width. It usually has a flat top. A plain block never has a bible or scroll on it.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">THE SCROLL</p> <p>It can be a single scroll—looks like a tube or similar to an open scroll such as in this picture. It can sit on top of a block or other headstone.</p>
			
<p style="text-align: center;">THE PULPIT or SLANT SURFACE BLOCK</p> <p>It is a block with either a slanted top—it often has a bible on it.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">THE RAISED-TOP MARKER</p> <p>It is close to the ground, about 6 inches above the ground. It usually has a flat surface.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">GROUND LEVEL or LAWN-TYPE MARKER</p> <p>It is flat with the ground or less than an inch above the ground. It usually does not have much information on it.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">UNUSUAL</p> <p>Some are in many categories and other fall into none of the categories</p>

HEADSTONE TYPES- SIDE B



Bi-Columnar

It has two or four legs that are connected by arches. It usually is used for husband and wife graves.



GREEK COLUMNS

It has a cylindrical base with a ball, urn, bowl or other decoration on top. The column going up is smooth and rounded.



OBELISKS— type 1

It has a square base and tapers upward. The top can be another pyramid, ball or other decoration.



CROSS-VAULT OBELISK

It has the same base, but the top looks like a roof of a church or house.



CRYPTS

They are enclosed graves. They usually are underground, but can be above ground. Often more than one person is buried in a crypt.



VAULT

A vault is an enclosed grave. They are also often underground. It covers just one or two graves.
